Project FAIR is part of the University of Edinburgh Business School and is built upon a strong body of research over the past decade into the psychological impact of dual salaries in the INGO sector, in particular their impact on employees' motivation, performance, and retention.

Topics such as international salary benchmarking, hyperinflation, cost of living, hard currency, hybrid working and equity are just some of the areas we are engaged in.

In 2019, we worked with around 25 INGOs to develop a set of <u>Principles and Standards</u> designed in order to help organisations develop a shared understanding of what fair reward means for the sector.
